- 3) The Board is to pursue a down zoning request for East Broadway from OR-3 to OR-1. This is as per the neighborhood plan.

- 5) Terra Long from Councilman Owens office reported the following:

Patterson Park would allow the Fleur-de-lis Garden Club to build raised beds in the playground area.

Bike security patrols will be increased for the Summer months.
