- 1) January Minutes approved.
- 2) Wayne - VP report – The local hazmat disposal site (paint, chemicals, etc) is located at 7501 Grade Lane.
- 3) Robin - Treasurers report - \$144 deposit from newsletter ads.
- 4) Jeff Artman LMPD / Darrin Riddle – Crime was very low the previous month, down 35% from the same time a year ago. People are reminded not to leave items visible in parked cars.
- 5) The OHNA banner was returned from Chris Freeman. Josh is to find out who did printing for Church of the Advent banners and get quote. There are 35 banner locations in the neighborhood. Perhaps individuals or groups/businesses want to sponsor banner(s).
- 6) Robin - Feb issue of newsletter was printed and distributed. Ad revenue was \$270 and printing cost was \$344. The Board voted and approved payment of the printing invoice. Several new advertisers have signed on for four quarter ad runs. Additionally, a local printer, Rick Goldberg of VIP, has quoted newsletter printing at \$300 using an environmentally friendly glossy ink format. Special thanks to Robin for all her excellent newsletter stewardship.

- 8) Vacant board positions need to be filled. All Board members are to approach at least one other person to see if they are willing to serve. A renter resident would be good since none are currently represented on the Board.
