- 1) Wayne Wohlbold has resigned his Board position and has moved out of town.
- 2) The Charette plans for the Wayside property are available for viewing at the OHNA website.
- 3) The next bulk trash pickup for our neighborhood is scheduled for June. We now have two annual pick up dates instead of four. Check the city website for exact dates at your address.
- 4) VP – No Report. Secretary – No Report
- 5) Treasurers Report:  
There was \$138 income from newsletter ad revenue.  
There is \$3,341 in the Highland Island maintenance account  
There is \$13,596 in the OHNA general account  
The treasurer will file the 2010 tax forms for OHNA
- 6) Officer Jeff Artman and Darrin Riddle report that theft from vehicles has risen somewhat, perhaps due to nicer weather. People are reminded NOT to leave visible items in their cars.
- 7) Carolyn Kromer from Tom Owens office reports the following:

March 27<sup>th</sup> is a Brightside Cleanup day.

Tom Owens office requests they be notified of potholes that need to be filled.

Tom Owens office is to meet with LMPD to discuss general issues. Please notify them of any issues that you feel the Police Department needs to address.

Please keep the street curbs and storm drains near you house clean and free of debris to help prevent flooding during Spring rains.

CVS pharmacy has expressed interest in redeveloping the site on Bardstown Road where Twig and Leaf is located. The Bardstown Road Overlay District encourages neighborhood associations to participate in the review process for this proposed development.

Tom Owens office is to explore the possibility of signs or curb painting to prevent cars from parking in front of driveways and blocking access.

8) The condo association located next to Monkey Wrench indicated that the agreement by Monkey Wrench to perform noise abatement procedures has been ignored.

9) The February meeting minutes were approved.

10) The Board voted unanimously to cancel the Original Highlands Arts and Music Festival for 2010 due to lack of revenue generated during 2009 and the tremendous amount of work required to stage the festival. The Treasurer will notify Budweiser of the decision. The President will draft a letter to the Baxter Avenue bars and John Granz informing them of the decision.

11) The Board is continuing to explore options and costs for replacing the Original Highlands banners around the neighborhood.

12) The Open Louisville Land Use Notification Amendment was presented to the Board with a request for our support. The amendment would require notification of land use requests to be presented to the public earlier in the process than is currently required. The Board supported the proposed amendment unanimously.

13) The Board has agreed to pay advertising costs of approximately \$60 to publicize a neighborhood wide yard sale scheduled for Saturday, June 5, 2010. This is a great opportunity to upcycle and repurpose those things you no longer want or need.

14) The Church Of The Advent has a need for volunteers to help with their food pantry distribution for people and pets.
